Summer 1 - Information Guide 1st Half Term 2017

Our learning this term

Our topic is 'Predators'

English – Our Literacy focus this will be on developing reading skills with particular reference to inference and deduction. The text we will read as a class is 'Krendlekraks'. Our writing focus will be on writing non-chronological reports and recounts.

Maths – We will begin this half term by continuing to develop our knowledge of fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, identifying equivalent fractions and ordering them. We will then move on to shape, investigate both 2 d and 3 d shapes angles and lines.

Science – Our 'Predator' topic will take us through a unit humans and animals. We will explore how to keep ourselves fit and healthy and how animals are similar to humans in many ways. We will explore and learn about food chains and find out just what predators like to eat!

Other subjects - The focus of this topic is Science, Art and DT. We will improve our drawing and painting skills by sketching and painting some of the largest predators on earth. We will link technology into Art by creating our own predators and develop our Design and technology skills by trying to make a predator with a moving part.

VISITS AND ENRICHMENT

This half term we will visit Paphos Zoo on Friday 5th May as the 'engage' part of our Predator topic. The children will be able to get up close (although not too close!) to some real life predators as well as seeing a range of other more common animals.

HOW TO HELP YOUR CHILD

Please support your child with their homework and encourage them to aim high and produce neat work of a good standard. Please also read with / listen to your child reading regularly (at least 1 hour a week) and comment and sign in the reading diary. Remember to question them about what they have read and make it a pleasurable experience.

HOMEWORK: A new homework sheet has been attached to the inside front cover of homework books with varying levels of challenge. Homework books will be sent home on a Friday and should be brought into school on a weekly basis when completed. Children also have a 'My Maths account' and weekly maths homework can be completed online (log in details have been sent home).

READING

Summer 1 – It is important that your child's reading book and reading record comes into school every day. They will work with an adult to improve their reading skills at least once a week through guided reading sessions and in other lessons.
