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Summer Term 2 2018 - Information Guide

Our learning this term Traders and Raiders

English — Our focus this half term will be on adventurous narrative texts. This will be linked to our work on Vikings and their legacy in the UK. We will identify features of adventure stories and write our own amazing Viking sagas. We will sit around the fire and recite and create kennings and haiku poems.

Maths – We will be learning about data handling, showing information in different ways and how to interpret it.

Science – We will be investigating habitats; the impact humans have on the environment and on animals.

History – We will learn all about the Vikings; their dress, lifestyle, food and transport as well as their place in History. **Art and Design** - Work will focus on using sketch books to record observations and improve techniques and review and revisit techniques.

P.E - We will develop our teamwork skills as well as striking and fielding skills through cricket and rounders.

PSHE - Our focus is changes and getting ready to move on to new challenges.

Computing - We are focusing on keyboard skills.

ENRICHMENT

We will grasp the horns (on the Viking helmet!) with a rune stone codebreaking challenge. We will visit several different habitats to identify, and compare the flora and fauna. We will also study how humans impact the environment and decide if this impact is positive or negative.

HOMEWORK:

A new homework sheet will be sent home with a variety of tasks and different levels of challenge. Homework should be brought into school when tasks are completed. If you choose to work on a bigger project over a few weeks please send it in when it is finished.

HOW TO HELP YOUR CHILD

Please support your child with their homework and encourage them to aim high and produce neat work of a good standard. Please also read with / listen to your child reading regularly and comment and sign in the reading diary. Remember to question them about what they have read and make it a pleasurable experience.

Please continue to take every opportunity to reinforce both multiplication and division facts as children can find this very tricky.

It is important that your child's reading book and reading record comes into school **every day**. They will work with an adult to improve their reading skills through individual / guided / shared reading sessions and in other lessons. Please remember that children should read for at least 3 hours per week. Our focus this half term is on how authors structure events and develop plots to foster excitement and suspense in the reader.
