Our learning this term...

Writing: We will continue to practise writing correctly punctuated sentences using adjectives and conjunctions, applying spelling rules such as prefixes and suffixes and polysyllabic words. Our first book will be Pet the cat.

Maths: Our focus next term will be place value to 100, money and time. We continue to apply addition, subtraction and multiplication strategies.

In history, we will be learning about the Great Fire of London. What can we learn from books and other sources about the fire? We will be consolidating the language we use to describe the passing of time. Can we find out the fire and help rebuild London?

In <u>science</u>, we will be learning about the importance of eating healthily. What would you put on your plate to make a healthy meal?

In <u>design technology</u>, we will be applying our learning of healthy foods in cooking and preparing meals. This will help us to prepare meals for a special class café.

FOREST SCHOOL

Due to the extremely hot weather, we have amended our forest school timetable for this half term. We will be having forest school on Thursday 10th June, Friday 25th June and either Monday 12th or Tuesday 13th July, depending on the class.

Home learning

Regular counting forwards and backwards to 50. Counting in 2s 5s and 10s. Please practise Year 1 tricky words. A sheet was sent home to each child. Please ask if you require another one.
