Autumn 1 2021/2022 - Information Guide

Our learning this term:

This half term, our focus will be settling into school and life in Year 2! We will also be reinforcing the core values of the school as well as developing and creating a class identity around our class names. This year, all classes in school will be named after famous international authors.

Writing: Our first writing unit is based on writing a set of instructions about how to look after an animal. We will also be developing our use of descriptive language by writing a story setting based on the text 'Where the Wild Things Are.' In phonics, we will be recapping Phase 5 sounds.

Maths: We will be looking at a range of methods to support our understanding of numbers to 100, focusing on place value. We will also begin to build on knowledge of addition and subtraction.

Science: Our science learning will be linked to animals and their basic needs eg. habitats.

In other subjects: We are focusing on colour and pattern in art and map skills in geography.
