Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Aware of own feelings and knows some actions and words can hurt other feelings.
- Adapt behaviour to different events, social situations and changes in routine.
- Enjoy the responsibility of carrying out small tasks.
- Initiate conversations, attend to and take account of what other say.

Communication and Language

- Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- Join in with and anticipates key phrases in rhymes and stories.
- Understand prepositions.
- Begin to understand 'how' and 'why' questions.
- Question why things happen and give explanations.
- Build up vocabulary.

Physical Development

- Continue to manage our own hygiene independently – going to the toilet, washing our hands.
- Move freely with confidence in a range of ways.
- Hold pencil between thumb and two fingers with control.
- Use one-handed tools, such as scissors, effectively.

Curious Creatures

Literacy

- Texts – Focused on animals and rhyme.
- Phase 1 Phonics – Alliteration.
- Playing games with words with the same initial sounds.
- Recognising when words have the same initial sounds
- Describe main story settings, events and principal characters in books.
- Begin to write own name.
- Begins to write some clearly recognisable

Mathematics

- Compare groups of objects – more, less, same.
- Separate a group of objects in different ways and know the total is the same.
- 1:1 correspondence when counting.
- Match some numerals to quantity.
- Positional language.
- Talk about the shapes of everyday objects.

Understanding the World

- Comment and ask questions about the natural world.
- Talk about some of the things they have observed.
- Show care and concern for living things and the environment.
- Easter.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Join in with dancing and ring games.
- Begin to move rhythmically.
- Use movement to express feelings.
- Imitate and create movement in response to music.
- Draw pictures.
