Our learning this term...

Writing: We will continue to practise writing correctly punctuated sentences and to begin to learn how to extend our writing. To start the term, we will be reading the book, 'Oliver's Vegetables'.

Maths: We will be counting backwards and forwards up to 20, + and – up to 20 and learning about place value within 50. We will also focus on addition and subtraction to 20.

In **History**, we will be learning about the Wright brothers, the evolution of the aeroplane and how its introduction impacted upon global travel. We will also link this work to some of the aircraft in Akrotiri (past and present).

In **Geography**, we will be learning about continents and oceans. We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify and label the countries, continents and oceans studied.

Our **Design and Technology** unit is all about healthy eating. We will be exploring our diets and looking at healthy lifestyles. We will be making a healthy meal.

In **Art**, we will be investigating and creating sculptures through junk modelling. This will link to our work on flight.

Visits and enrichment

We will be using our local environment. We are in an ideal place to study our curriculum block based on Flight. Obviously, our plans for trips and visitors have to consider COVID restrictions.

Home learning

We will be sending home learning books home each Friday. The home learning opportunities will be linked to the week's class learning, including phonics, handwriting and maths.

Reading

We are continuing to focus on reading and will be reading with your child 1:1 and in Guided Reading. Please ensure that reading books and reading records are in school every day for individual reading. This term, once children are secure with reading Phase 5 phonics, they will move onto the Accelerated Reading system.

How to help your child

Regular reading – please initial when you have read with your child, we would love children to read at least 3 times a week at home. When reading with your child, don't forget to ask them questions to ensure that they understand what they are reading.
Regular counting forwards and backwards to 50.

Additional information

Mosquito repellent should be applied before school. Due to the inclement weather, please ensure children have a coat.

Please ensure all clothing is named and labelled.
