Our learning this term...

<u>Writing:</u> We will be writing a persuasive letter including a balanced argument. We will look at rhythm and rhyme in poetry and we will be writing a short narrative demonstrating all of the language features we have studied this year. This will be based on based on a painting that we have explored in art.

Maths: The areas of maths we will be looking at this half term are: time - telling the time to 5 minutes, using the 24-hour clock and problem solving; angles - looking at right angles, comparing angles, understanding the terms horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular; shape - recognise and describe 2D and 3D shapes; and measure — understanding and using mass and capacity.

Science: We will investigate light and shadows; recognising light sources, how light can be reflected, the dangers of the sun as well as understanding how shadows are formed and can change.

<u>Art</u>: We will look at various representations of light and try to replicate the techniques used. We will also complete an artist study on Thomas Kincaid, who was known as the painter of light.

<u>Design and Technology:</u> Our DT focus this half term is sewing. We will join fabrics using running stitch, over sewing and back stitch.
