Our learning this half term will encompass a range of skills to support the whole curriculum.

Writing: We will continue to practise writing correctly punctuated sentences and learning how to extend our writing using 'and' and 'because'. To begin the term, we will be writing fact files about animals.

<u>Maths</u>: Our focus next term will be multiplication and division. We will look at how to count in groups (early multiplication strategies) and sharing objects. We will also focus on fractions, exploring half and quarter.

<u>Science</u>: We will be learning about humans and other animals and how we categorise animals. We will link this to our English work on fact files.

<u>DT:</u> We will be focusing on structures and how to make a structure stronger.

We will be visiting Pafos Zoo (Monday 24th April) to enhance our knowledge and understanding of categorising animals and also linking with our English topic on animal fact files.
